

DO YOU SUPPORT THE POLICIES OF NAC?

- **Abortion on demand up to birth, for any reason** – (NAC support abortion at 8 and 9 months of pregnancy, regardless of the growing evidence that the baby can feel pain as early as 20 weeks and could survive if born at 22 weeks.)
"NAC's policy is that there should be no legal or medical restrictions to the availability of abortion. This means we are opposed to any upper time limit on abortion." Fiddy Jones, former NAC steering committee member.
- **Abortions performed by staff other than fully qualified doctors, eg any woman**
"...the woman may request anyone she chooses (e.g. doctor, nurse, another woman) to perform the abortion." (Quotations from the NAC conference resolution, cited in NAC's The Abortion Law We Want)
- **No restrictions on embryo experimentation even for cosmetic purposes**
- **Eugenic abortion to kill all disabled babies, no matter how minor the disability, a case of clear discrimination against the disabled**
"...unless routine screening is offered to all women, and abortion is also offered where tests are positive, then abortion will not 'catch' all foetal abnormality."

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE NATIONAL ABORTION CAMPAIGN

- ◆ **EVEN PRO-CHOICE STUDENTS HAVE REJECTED NAC BECAUSE NAC IS TOO EXTREME.** 60% of Cambridge students recently opposed affiliation to NAC. Even those who support abortion recognise the need for safeguards to protect the unborn baby and would oppose the current availability of abortion on demand.
- ◆ **STUDENT MONEY SHOULD HELP STUDENTS NOT FUND SOME EXTREME POLITICAL CAMPAIGN.** Why affiliate to an organisation when money could be better spent on computing facilities and helping students? The NUS recently cut its funding to NAC. Very few student unions are affiliated to NAC. NAC is a worn out organisation. With over 500 abortions a day, one has to ask what is NAC doing that is worth paying for?
- ◆ **STUDENT UNIONS EXIST TO REPRESENT THE ENTIRE STUDENT BODY, NOT TAKE SIDES ON ANY CONTROVERSIAL ISSUE.** It exists to facilitate freedom of speech, freedom of information, not to push a single agenda. *"The National Abortion Campaign is not an advice service: it's not in our remit, and never has been. It is a campaigning group."* Janet Mearns, NAC Secretary 1998.
- ◆ **AFFILIATION TO NAC IS ILLEGAL** as it breaches the charitable status of the Union by funding a political organisation.
